This year the Academy is celebrating it's 75th Anniversary. Founded in 1922, the Academy's mission is to promote the art and science of vision care. Academy Fellows are held to the highest ethical and professional standards of practice. The Academy hosts annual meetings in North America and biannual meetings around the world. The Academy's journal, Optometry and Vision Science, is recognized worldwide as a chronicle of the scientific and professional development of optometry. The American Optometric Foundation, an affiliation of the Academy, presents nearly \$100,000.00 in awards and grants every year. As a Fellow of the Academy, Dr. Shen supports and participates in these activities.
